- This round will be scored based on individual performance, accuracy, and the number of correct answers.

Basic Rules & Guidelines for All Rounds

All students from Classes 6 to 12 are eligible to participate.

There are two competition pools:

Pool 1: Classes 6 to 8

Pool 2: Classes 9 to 12

- The difficulty level of the questions will vary based on the competition pool.
- All rounds will be conducted in English.
- The registration fee is INR 150. Students can compete in all three categories if they are interested.
- The dates of the exams will be notified on the website.
- Participants are expected to maintain fairness, discipline, and integrity throughout the competition.
- Finalists will be notified in advance and will be required to travel to the designated venue for the offline round. Details will be provided at a later date.
- Prizes, certificates, and recognition will be awarded to the top performers in each category.
- Any changes in the exam mode or pattern will be communicated in advance.
- The decision taken by the organizing committee will be final and binding.
